

### **TOUR OVERVIEW**

During this trip you will visit many places not visited in a single day such as: Rosa Blanca Bay, Punta Puccuna, Sardina Bay, where you can see many interesting birds and fish. Rosa Blanca Bay is a beautiful white sand beach in an area of small lagoons with clear blue water with the option of snorkeling with great possibility of finding Punta Blanca sharks and huge rays at the bottom of the lagoon. This area is also suitable for a short walk, you will discover the sea turtles in the clear water and walk along the lava and coral coasts.

Then we continue to Punta Puccuna, which is located in the northeast part of the island. It is formed by a small bay that consists of three beaches. It is a unique and paradisiacal place. The presence of lava cones behind the



beaches and the spectacular views of Cerro Brujo and León Dormido make this place an ideal place for photography.

The rock formations around Punta Pitt are home to 3 types of boobies: the Bluefoot, Red Footed and Nazca Booby; Also many frigate birds can be seen here. If you are lucky, you will find bottlenose dolphins while browsing.

If you are interested in fishing activity, the captain will show you the local fishing techniques - your lunch will be the catch of the day! There is a time to relax in the bay of Sardina, in the white sand that looks like dust, with the presence of sea lions and pelicans.
