



TOUR OVERVIEW

The Interpretation Center was inaugurated by The President of The Republic of Ecuador, Dr. Jamil Mahuad and The Prince of Asturias, Felipe de Borbon, in August 1998. The exposition of the Interpretation Center offers a journey through the history of the islands from the context of man, nature and conservation.

The display of Natural History explains the series of natural circumstances, like the volcanic origin of the islands, the distance of the continent, the marine currents, the special climate, the arrival of different species, their establishment, among other information.

The exhibition of human history recounts, in a chronological manner, the most significant events relating to the discovery and colonization of the Galápagos Islands. Phase II of the human history display provides information on the reality of the Galapagos today; the problems and the struggles of various institutions and people to protect the Galapagos.
