BARTHOLOMEW ISLAND

BREAKFAST/BARTOLOME ISLAND BOASTS ONE OF THE MOST STUNNING LANDSCAPES IN THE GALAPAGOS, MAKING IT THE MOST PHOTOGRAPHED OF ALL THE ISLANDS. FROM ITS SUMMIT, ENJOY BREATHTAKING VIEWS OF TWO PICTURESQUE BAYS AND STRIKING VOLCANIC FORMATIONS. AT THE ISLAND'S BASE, GALAPAGOS PENGUINS — THE ONLY PENGUIN SPECIES NORTH OF THE EQUATOR — SHUFFLE ALONG VOLCANIC LEDGES, WHILE SEA LIONS LOUNGE ON ROCKY PLATFORMS, READY TO INTERACT WITH PASSING SNORKELERS. BENEATH THE WAVES, VIBRANT SCHOOLS OF TROPICAL FISH WEAVE THROUGH ROCKS SURROUNDED BY SEA URCHINS, STARFISH, AND ANEMONES. A CRESCENT-SHAPED PINK-AND-WHITE SANDY BEACH LIES NEAR THE ICONIC PINNACLE ROCK, OFTEN VISITED BY SEA TURTLES NESTING OR RESTING AFTER THEIR ARDUOUS TASK, THE SNORKELING EXPERIENCE ON THE SCENIC TOUR OFFERS A CHANCE TO EXPLORE THIS VIBRANT UNDERWATER WORLD./DINNER

NORTH SEYMOUR ISLAND

BREAKFAST/ THIS ISLAND IS TEAMING WITH LIFE! YOU MIGHT HAVE TOGIVE WAY TO A PASSING SEA LION OR MARINE IGUANA; BLUE-FOOTED BOOBY NESTS SIT BESIDE THE TRAIL WHERE MATING PAIRS PERFORM THEIR COURTSHIP DANCE. FURTHER ALONG, THE ROCKY SHORE IS INTERSPERSED WITH WHITE SAND, WHILE LARGE FLOCKS OF PELICANS MASS FOR A DIVE-BOMB FEEDING-FRENZY, PAINTING A TABLEAU FROM AGES LONG PAST FOR US. THE TRAIL TURNS INLAND TO REVEAL THE LARGEST NESTINGSITE IN THE GALAPAGOS OF THE "MAGNIFICENT FRIGATEBIRD." THESE HUGE, DARK ACROBATS HAVE TWO-METER (6-FOOT) WINGSPANS, AND MALES, WITH PUFFED UP SCARLET THROAT SACKS, SIT PRECARIOUSLY PERCHED IN LOW BUSHES TO WATCH OVER THEIR EQUALLY LARGE CHICKS. THIS IS A WALKING EXCURSION AND INVOLVES UNEVENROCKY TERRAIN. DRY LANDING.

IN THE AFTERNOON, WE VISIT LAS BACHAS BEACH. DINNER.

GARRAPATERO BEACH

IT IS A SERENE REFUGE AND ONE OF THE BEST PLACES TO RELAX AND DISCONNECT FROM THE WORLD. UPON REACHING THE ENTRANCE OF THE BEACH, A PLEASANT 15-MINUTE WALK ALONG A PAVED TRAIL AWAITS, LEADING YOU DIRECTLY TO THE SOFT WHITE SANDS OF THIS IDYLLIC COAST.

THE BEACH NOT ONLY OFFERS A PERFECT ESCAPE WITH ITS STUNNING LANDSCAPE AND CRYSTAL-CLEAR WATERS BUT ALSO SERVES AS A SIGNIFICANT ECOLOGICAL POINT OF INTEREST. A SHORT DISTANCE AWAY, YOU WILL FIND A FASCINATING BRACKISH LAGOON, A VITAL HABITAT FOR LOCAL BIODIVERSITY. HERE, IF WE ARE LUCKY, ONE CAN OBSERVE THE RARE GALAPAGOS VARIETY OF THE AMERICAN FLAMINGO, A SPECTACULAR SIGHT OF BIRDS IN THEIR NATURAL ENVIRONMENT. ADDITIONALLY, THE LAGOON ATTRACTS VARIOUS SEASONAL WADING BIRDS THAT ADD A TOUCH OF MAGIC TO THE SCENERY WITH THEIR ELEGANT PRESENCE.

HIGHLANDS

THE NATIVE SCALESIA FOREST OF EL CHATO TORTOISE RESERVE IS THE BEST PLACE TO SEARCH FOR GALAPAGOS GIANT TORTOISES IN THEIR MOST AUTHENTIC SETTING! DESPITE THE INTERESTING BREEDING CENTERS - WHERE YOU ARE GUARANTEED TO FIND TORTOISES IN THEIR CORRALS - THERE IS NOTHING BETTER THAN TO OBSERVE THEM IN THEIR WILD ENVIRONMENT. THOUGH IT CAN BE QUITE MOIST AND MUDDY, YOUR VISIT MAY TURN INTO AN ADVENTUROUS QUEST WHEN THEY HAVE LEFT THEIR FAVORITE POND SILENTLY. THE TWIN CRATERS ARE FOUND ON EITHER SIDE OF THE ROAD LEADING TO PUERTO AYORA. THESE IMPRESSIVE FORMATIONS ARE NOT REALLY VOLCANIC CRATERS AND WERE FORMED BY MAGMA DOMES, WHICH HARDENED ON THE OUTSIDE WHILE THE LAVA CONTINUED FLOWING INSIDE, LEAVING HUGE AND EMPTY MAGMA CHAMBERS THAT EVENTUALLY COLLAPSED, LEAVING TWO LARGE HOLES. THE CRATERS LIE WITHIN A LUSH SCALESIA CLOUD FOREST, A HIGH-ALTITUDE PLANT SPECIES THAT ARE ENDEMIC TO THE GALAPAGOS. THIS AREA IS ALSO HOME TO THE CARPENTER FINCH, WHICH USES TOOLS TO SEARCH FOR FOOD. THERE MAY ALSO BE OPPORTUNITIES TO SEE THE VERMILLION FLYCATCHER, A SMALL RED-BREASTED BIRD
